
Laura Fraga

Block of the Month

This years BOM 2021 will be Novelty Blocks. Many times they will coincide with a Holiday for that month. Reminder that the BOM is an opportunity to use your stash. I will provide the main fabric as supplies last. As always I am here to help: provide fabric, drop off material and pick up completed blocks. Thank you all for participating.

Make up to 5 for the BOM raffle.

Flower Pot

Block size is 10"

Supplies




Color 1: one 4-7/8 x 9-3/4" strip


Color 2 : one 4-7/8" square AND one 2-7/8" x 8-5/8" strip

Color 3: one 4-7/8" square AND one 2-1/2" x 15-1/2" strip AND one 2-7/8" x 8-5/8" strip

Cutting:




Color 1: 4-7/8 x 9-3/4" strip into two 4-7/8" squares. Stack these squares and cut them once on the diagonal to make four half square triangles. You will only need three for a block.



Color 2: 4-7/8" square in half once on the diagonal to make two half square triangles. You only need one of these HSTs.

Color 2: cut 2-7/8" x 8-5/8" strip into three 2-7/8" squares. Stack the squares and cut them once on the diagonal to make six half square triangles.



Color 3: 4-7/8" square in half along one diagonal to make two half square triangles. Color 3: 2-1/2" x 15-1/2" strip into two 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles and one 2-1/2" square.

Color 3: 2-7/8" x 8-5/8" strip into three 2-7/8" squares. Stack the squares and cut them once on the diagonal to make six half square triangles.

Assembly:



Unit A: using a scant 1/4" seam, sew four Color 2 2-7/8" half square triangles right sides together to four Color 3 half square triangles of the same size to make four Half Squares. Press seams to darker sides. Assemble Unit A by sewing together, the Color 3 2-1/2" square, two Half Squares, and an extra Color 3 2-7/8" half square triangle. Make one Unit



Unit B: sew together two Half Squares, and an extra Color 3 2-7/8" half square triangle. Add a Color 3 4-7/8" half square triangle to the right side of the joined Half Squares-and-triangle.



Block of the Month cont'd



Unit C sew a Color 1 4-7/8" half square triangle to the left edge of a Color 2 4-7/8" half square triangle. Add another Color 1 4-7/8" half square triangle to the top edge of the Color 2 half square triangle. Lastly add another Color 1 4-7/8" half square triangle to the bottom slant edge of the Color 2 half square triangle.

- unit D

Unit D: sew Color 2 2-7/8" half square triangle to one end of a Color 3 rectangle in the orientation shown at left.



Unit E: Sew a Color 2 2-7/8" half square triangle to one end of a Color 3 rectangle in the orientation shown at left.

Sew Unit A to the top edge of Unit B...



Then add Unit C to the pieced unit just made.



Add Unit D to the bottom edge, and then Unit E to the right edge, and sew a Color 3 4-7/8" half square triangle to the bottom slant corner to complete the block.

Quilt Blocks for Habitat for Humanity

North Cities Quilt Guild has partnered with the Yorba Linda Presbyterian Church Mission Committee and friends in committing to provide quilts for one family per year to be included in the family's Welcome Gift Basket on move-in day.

These will be larger bed sized quilts queen/full and twin size depending on the family's needs.

Sew, let's get busy!

The red and white blocks will be very simple, 5" finished (5.5" with seam allowances). This traditional block is called "Bulls-Eye" or as Marianne Fons calls it in her "Love of Quilting" July/ August 2014 magazine, "Cubbyholes".

We will use scrappy reds and whites. Cutting for one block

From Red: Cut one 3.5" square

From White: Cut two 1.5" x 3.5" rectangles Cut two 1.5" x 5.5" rectangles

Reverse the colors for a second block. Make LOTS of blocks! I dare you to make a dent in your fabric stash.

Reds can vary from Barbie Pink to (my favorite) Burgundy wine. Other colors can be present in the print, but it should read as red. The same goes for the whites and creams.

Rita will have fabric on her porch if you would like to use it.

I will leave a basket on my porch for you to drop off your blocks or you can mail them to me.

Welcome and join with us for another opportunity to share our love of quilts with others.


I am turning in my first UFO for 2021! Mystery Retreat 2020 "Pineapple Punch" Quilted by Angel Fink.

Tips for taking quilt photos for Show and Tell

Please don't stress, you are not submitting your quilt to a show. This is just you, showing your fabulous quilt to your guild friends.

- Take your photo outdoors between 8-10 am or 4-6 pm or anytime during a cloudy day.
- Avoid shadows on the quilt.
- Have someone hold the quilt if possible. (try not to include their hands or feet) Try to get the quilt flat or even. If you don't have someone to hold try to lay it on the grass or drape it over a bush, chair, table, etc.
- Take one close up, try to zoom in as close as possible or provide detail of the quilting, Can include the label but not necessary
- Provide a brief description, quilt name, size and who quilted.
