## Double Aster BOM April 2024 <br> (make 2 blocks)

Color 1: one $5-1 / 8$ " x 10-1/4" strip

Color 2: one 3-7/8" x 7-3/4" strip

Color 3: one $2-3 / 8$ " x 4-3/4" strip AND one 3" x 6" strip one $2-5 / 8$ " square


Color 4: one 2-3/8" x 4-3/4" strip
one 3 " x 18" strip
one $5-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 10-3 / 4$ " strip

Cutting:


Color 1: $5-1 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 4$ " strip into two $5-1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Stack and cut these once on the diagonal


Color 2: 3-7/8" x 7-3/4" strip into two 3-7/8" squares. Stack these and cut them once on the diagonal


Color 3: 2-3/8" x 4-3/4" strip into two 2-3/8" squares. Stack and cut these diagonally once
Color 3: $3^{\prime \prime} \times 6$ " strip into two 3 " squares and cut these diagonally once


Color 4: 2-3/8" x 4-3/4" strip into two 2-3/8" Small squares. Stack and cut diagonally once.
Color 4: 3" x 18" strip into six 3 " Medium squares and cut these diagonally once.
Color 4: $5-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 10-3 / 4$ " strip into two $5-3 / 8$ " Large squares and cut these diagonally once.

## Sewing:



Sew pairs of SMALL Color 3 and Color 4 half square triangles right sides together to make four pieced triangles as shown at top left.
Add a MEDIUM Color 4 triangle to the Color 3 side of each of those, making four units as shown middle left.
Add a Color 2 half square triangle to the right to make four of the units shown at bottom left.
These are now Color 2 pieced units.

Sew together pairs of Color 3 and Color 4 MEDIUM triangles to make four of the units shown at top left. Add another Color 4 MEDIUM triangle to the Color 3 side of each of those to make four of the units shown at middle left.

Now add a Color 1 half square triangle to each of the units we just made, making four of the units shown at bottom left. These are now Color 1 pieced units.


Sew one of the Color 2 pieced units to each of the Color 1 pieced units. Make four of these.


Sew the Color 3 2-5/8" square to the bottom right edge of one of the larger pieced units, starting at a point 1/4" from the inner edge of the square and stitching to the outer edge.


Working clockwise, add another pieced unit to the bottom of that.


Continue to add units in a clockwise fashion.


After adding the fourth unit, fold the block right sides together to align the remaining un-sewn seam, and stitch that closed.


Now add the four Color 4 LARGE half square triangles to the four corners, and the block is complete!
