October 25: Lecture: **Applique Journey**

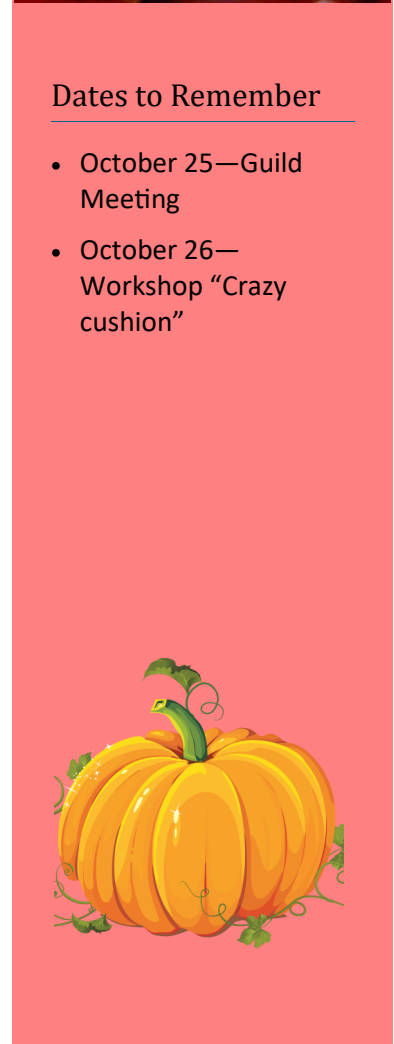

Workshop With Becky Mc Daniel

“Crazy Cushion”



The last workshop of 2021! Come join the fun!

If you want to feel comfortable, this is the workshop for you!

Becky McDaniel will be the master instructor! She will teach us how to make a paper-pieced CRAZY CUSHION. **This is how she describes the class:**

“This “Crazy Cushion” is paper pieced with 3 different designs—**Star Jasmine, Pineapple, Flying Geese** “I will show you how to do paper piecing using a light box. This technique makes it so much easier to get the points perfect! You will learn how to make the welting and the large hand quilting with pearl cotton to make your cushion pop.” “This cushion also has a zipper which makes it easier to wash if necessary. I will show you how to set and stabilize your zipper and put a fun handle on so that carrying your cushion is easier!”

Kits are available in 3 sizes at \$35 each. The kit will include:

- ⇒ Printed Paper Piecing Pages (16 pages)
- ⇒ 16x16x3 firm foam cushion
- ⇒ 3 ¾ yards of cotton cording
- ⇒ 22” x 1 ½” strap
- ⇒ 22” zipper
- ⇒ Pattern

Becky will also have available:

Neutral Fabric @ \$11/yd

YLI Monofilament Thread @ \$8

Sue Spargo #8 embroidery thread @ \$5

Big Stitch Needles @ \$6 for a package of 12 needles

9”x9” wool mats @ \$18

Becky will also have instructions on how to order the cushion from an online vendor or you can buy foam at any local upholstery supply.

Recipe

As in the past, we have been asking our guest speakers to share a favorite recipe. Here is one of Becky McDaniel's favorites. Perhaps you could give it a try or share the recipe with a friend.

"Caprese Pasta with Shrimp"

Combine in a large bowl while pasta cooks:

- 1 small white onion chopped
- Grape or cherry tomatoes sliced in half (I never measure... just a bunch.. 1 - 2 cups..)
- Bunch of basil cut into ribbons
- Container of pearl mozzarella
- Olive oil - probably 1/4 C. (I just pour it in...)
- Garlic salt and pepper

Toss with spaghetti or your favorite pasta.

I add the basil lime shrimp from the mixture at this point. Serve nuts.

UFO Challenge

Do you have any projects that you've started and haven't quite completed yet? Here is a fun challenge for you. Sign up for the Guild's UFO Challenge and complete 5 projects this upcoming year. All you need to do is complete the UFO entry form with the names and descriptions of 5 projects that you would like to complete and turn it in with a \$10.00 entry fee (for prizes and supplies). Mail the entry to me, Anna Lee 1224 W. Primrose Drive, Orange, Calif. 92868 or, if we have any live events, you can give it to me there. Entries are accepted right up to the last turn in at the general meeting September 26, 2022. Forms will be in the newsletter and at the UFO table at the monthly meetings.

You will receive a participation ribbon upon my receiving an entry form. If the form is handed to me in person, you will receive your ribbon then. If through the mail, I will contact you as to where we can meet so that you may receive your ribbon. There will be five turn-ins from January to September 2022.

When you submit a "completed" UFO (that means it has been quilted, bound and has an affixed label) by email with photos or at a live meeting, we will put in a ticket for that night's turn-in prize drawing and you will receive your first 'turn-in' button. This will happen with each UFO you have turned in. Turn-in months are January, March, June, July, September and online turn-ins should be submitted by the Friday before the meeting. There is no limit as to how many UFO's you turn at a time. At the last turn-in, there will be a drawing for everyone who has completed any UFO and a final drawing for those who have completed all 5 UFO's.

Block Of The Month October 2021

This years BOM 2021- 2022 will be Quilting and Sewing notion theme. You will get to use different sewing techniques during this next year.

**Make 2- one for yourself and one to turn in.
You will receive a different block in return.**

The block is 12 1/2 " when completed.

**DISREGARD THE NUMBER AND
LETTERING ON THE IMAGES IN THIS
PATTERN.**

Cutting instructions:

Background (white)

- 1 - 1 1/2 x 7 1/2 " rectangle
- 9 - 1 1/2 x 1 1/2 " squares
- 5 - 1 x 1 " squares
- 1 - 2 x 4 1/2" rectangle
- 1 - 1 1/2 x 8" rectangle
- 2 - 2 1/2 x 2 1/2 " squares
- 1 - 3 x 3 1/2" rectangle
- 1 - 2 x 3 1/2" rectangle
- 1 - 1 1/2 x 3" rectangle
- 1 - 1 1/2 x 4 1/2" rectangle
- 1 - 6 x 6 1/2" rectangle
- 1 - 5 1/2 x 6" rectangle
- 1 - 4 1/2 x 4 1/2 " square
- 1 - 1 1/2 x 6 1/2" rectangle
- 1 - 1 1/2 x 3 1/2" rectangle

Needle (gray)

- 1 - 5 x 5" square
- 1 - 1 1/2 x 1 1/2 "square
- 1- 1 x 1" square



Thread strand (choose your color)

- 4 - 1 x 3 1/2" rectangles
- 1 - 3 x 3 " square
- 4 - 2 x 2 " square
- 2 - 1 x 2 1/2" square
- 1 - 1 x 1 1/2 " rectangle
- 1- 1 x 1 1/2 " rectangle
- 1 - 1 1/2 x 3 1/2" rectangle

Thread stripes (choose your color)

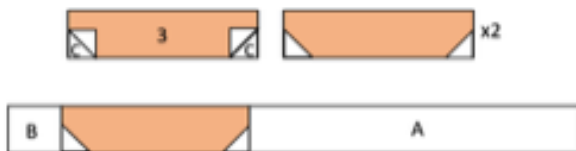
- 1 -1 1/2x 3 1/2" rectangle
- 1 - 1 x 3/ 1/2 " rectangle
- 1 -1 1/2 x 3 1/2 " rectangle

Wood Spool (Tan)

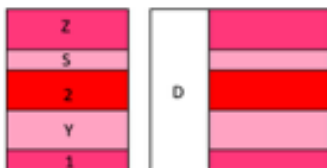
- 2 - 1 1/2 x 4 1/2 " rectangles

Spool construction:

1) Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 4 1" white squares. With the right sides facing, layer the white 1" square on the bottom left corner of a tan 1 1/2 x 4 1/2" rectangle. (make 2 of these). Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam and press. Sew a white 1 1/2 x 1 1/2" square to the left of the tan piece. Sew the white 1 1/2 x 7 1/2" rectangle to the right of the tan piece. This unit is measuring (1 1/2" x 12 1/2"). Keep the other tan piece for later.



2) Sew the Thread Stripes 1 1/2 x 3 1/2" rectangle to the Thread Strand 1 x 3 1/2" rectangle, then sew the Thread Stripe 1 1/2 x 3 1/2" rectangle, then sew the Thread Strand 1 1/2 x 3 1/2" rectangle to the previous section, then sew the Thread Stripe 1 x 3 1/2" rectangle. Sew 2 x 4 1/2" to the side of the tread stripes just sewn.

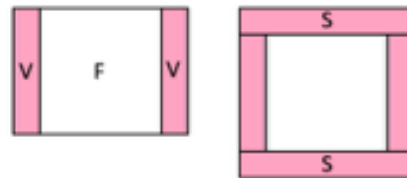


Thread construction:

3) Sew Thread strand 1 x 3 1/2" rectangle to White 3 x 3 1/2" rectangle. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Thread strand 3 x 3" square piece and layer that piece on the top right corner of the white rectangle. Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam and press. Then draw a diagonal line on White 2 1/2 x 2 1/2" square and place on the upper right hand corner. Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam and

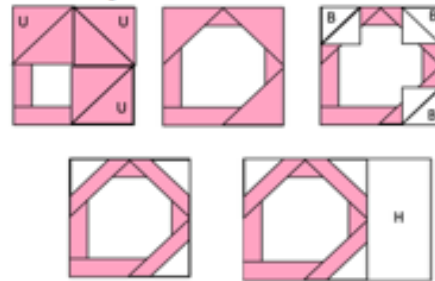


4) Sew the Thread stand 1 x 2 1/2" rectangle to the White 2 1/2 x 2 1/2" square. Then sew the Thread strand 1 x 3 1/2" rectangles to the upper and lower parts of the previous piece



sewn.

5) Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of three Tread strand 2 x 2" squares and place them as in the image below. Then sew the White 1 1/2 x 1 1/2" squares as per the image below. Sew the White 2 x 3 1/2" rectangle to the unit just sewn.



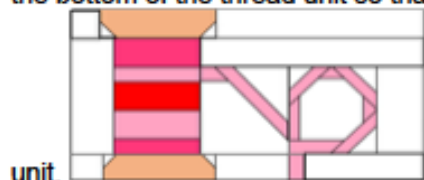
6) Sew the previous 2 units together as in image below. Sew the White 1 1/2 x 8" rectangle on the top of the unit just sewn. Then sew the Spool on the left side of this unit.



7) To sew this next section you will need the White 1 1/2 x 3" rectangle, Thread strand 1 x 1 1/2" rectangle and the White 1 1/2 x 4 1/2" rectangle as per image below. Sew the top of the spool section to the left of the section just sewn. Add a 1 1/2 x 1 1/2" white square to the left of the just sewn section.



8. Sew the top spool unit to the top of the thread unit and join the bottom spool unit to the bottom of the thread unit so that the thread



unit.
9. With the right sides facing, layer a 1 x 1 " White square piece on the top right corner of the 1 1/2 x 1 1/2 " Grey piece. Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam and press. With the right sides facing, layer a 1 1/2 x 1 1/2" White square piece on the bottom left corner. Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam and press.



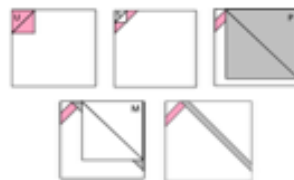
10. With the right sides facing, layer a 1 1/2 x 1/12" White square on the top left corner of the Thread strand 1 1/2 x 2" rectangle. Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam and press. Repeat on the bottom right corner of the Thread Strand piece. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Gray 1 x 1" square. With the right sides facing, layer the Gray 1 x 1" square piece on the bottom left corner of the X piece. Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam and press. Sew the 1 1/2 x 3 1/2" White rectangle to the right side of the last section sewn.



11. With the right sides facing, layer a Thread Strand 2 x 2 " square on the top left corner of the 5 1/2 x 6" rectangle. Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam and press. With the right sides facing, layer a 1 1/2 x 1 1/2" square on the top left corner of the 5 1/2 x 6 " rectangle. Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam and press.

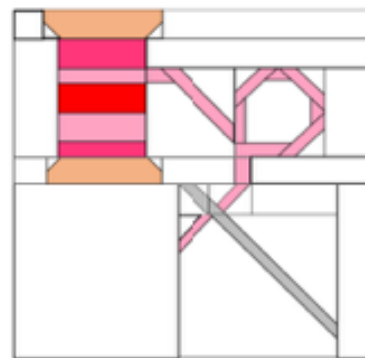
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Grey 5 x 5" square.

With the right sides facing, layer the P piece on the top right corner of the L piece. Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam and press. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 4 1/2 x 4 1/2" White square. With the right sides facing, layer the White 4 1/2 x 4 1/2" square. Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam and press.



12. Join these last two sections together as in image below.

13. Sew the thread unit to the top of the needle unit to form the finished block

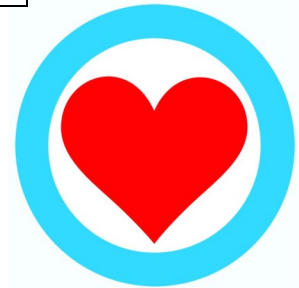

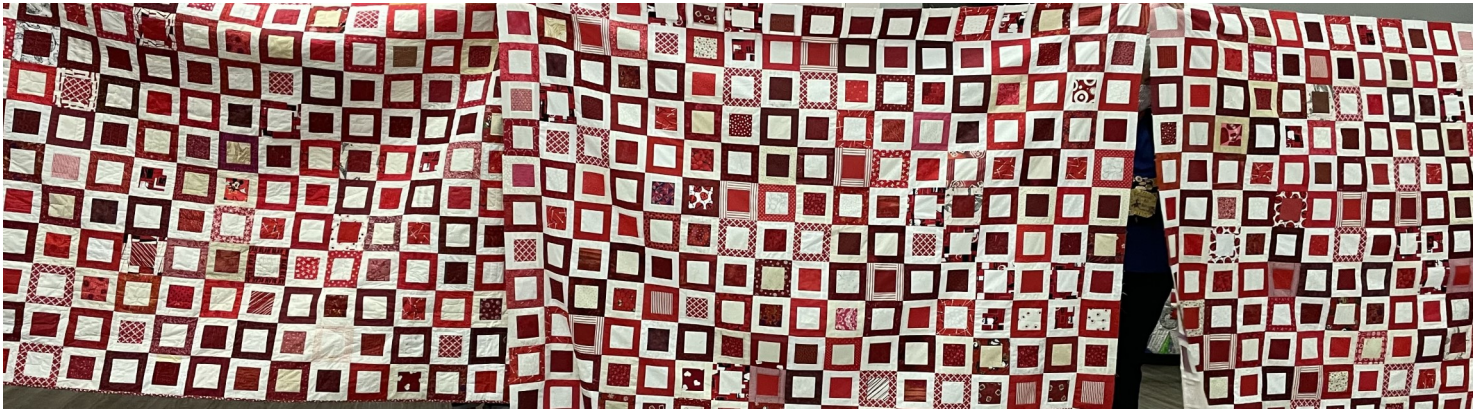
