Note: The block cutting instructions contain measurements for both a 9" finished block and a 12" finished block. Be sure not to mix up the measurements.

	Piece	Shape	# Pieces Required	Strip Width	First Cut Size	# of Pieces Required	Final Cut
Light	A		16	9" block - 2 1/2" 12" block - 3"	9" block - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" 12" block - 3" x 3"	8 squares	Cut each square once on the diagonal.
Medium	B		1	9" block - 3 3/4" 12" block - 4 3/4"	9" block - 3 3/4" x 3 3/4" 12" block - 4 3/4" x 4 3/4"	1 square	(no additional cuts)
Medium	C		4	9" block - 5 3/4" 12" block - 7 1/4"	9" block - 5 3/4" x 5 3/4" 12" block - 7 1/4" x 7 1/4"	1 square	Cut square twice on the diagonal.
Dark	D		4	9" block - 3 3/8" 12" block - 3 3/8"	9" block - 3 3/8" x 3 3/8" 12" block - 3 3/8" x 3 3/8"	2 squares	Cut each square once on the diagonal
Dark	E		8	9" block - 4 1/2" 12" block - 5 1/2"	9" block - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" 12" block - 5 1/2" x 5 1/2"	2 squares	Cut each square twice on the diagonal.

Sewing Instructions

Note: Use 1/4" seam allowance for all seams.

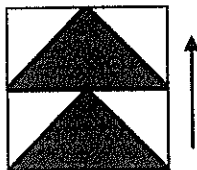
1. Sew an "A" piece to the left side of a "E" piece. Sew along the diagonal. Press to the "A" piece.



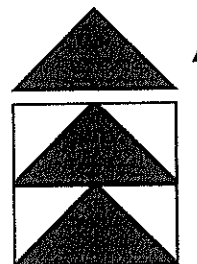
Sew an "A" piece to the right side of the "E" piece. Sew along the diagonal. Press to the "A" piece. **Make 8 total.**



2. Sew two step 1 units together. **Make 4 total.**



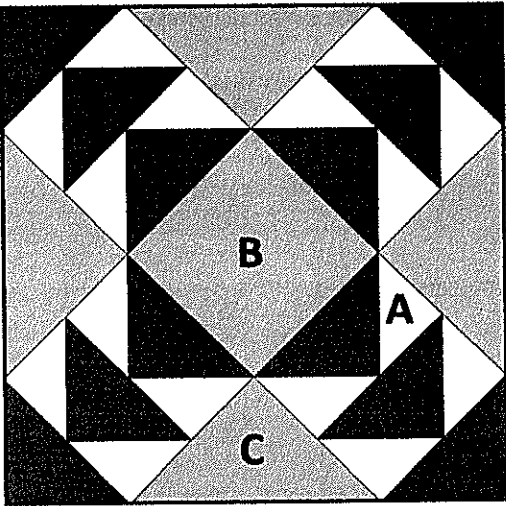
3. Sew a "D" piece to the top of the step 2 unit. **Make 4 total.**

Sewing Instructions (continued)

Note: Use $\frac{1}{8}$ " seam allowance for all seams.

4. Sew a "C" piece to the sides of a step 3 unit. Press to the "C" pieces. Make 2 rows.
5. Sew two of the step 3 units to opposite sides of the "B" piece. Make 1 row.

6. Assemble rows.
