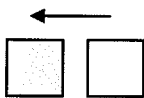
**Note: The block cutting instructions contain measurements for both a 9" finished block and a 12" finished block. Be sure not to mix up the measurements.**

	Piece	Shape	# Pieces Required	Strip Width	First Cut Size	# of Pieces Required	Final Cut
Light 1	A		10	9" block - 2" 12" block - 2 1/2"	9" block - 2" x 2" 12" block - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"	10 squares	(no additional cuts)
Light 2	B		4	9" block - 3 7/8" 12" block - 4 7/8"	9" block - 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" 12" block - 4 7/8" x 4 7/8"	2 squares	Cut each square <b>once</b> on the diagonal.
Medium	C		10	9" block - 2" 12" block - 2 1/2"	9" block - 2" x 2" 12" block - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"	10 squares	(no additional cuts)
Dark	D		4	9" block - 3 7/8" 12" block - 4 7/8"	9" block - 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" 12" block - 4 7/8" x 4 7/8"	2 squares	Cut each square <b>once</b> on the diagonal.

## Sewing Instructions

**Note: Use 1/4" seam allowance for all seams.**

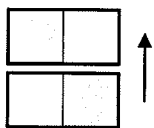
1. Sew an "A" piece to a "C" piece. Press toward the "C" piece. **Make 10.**



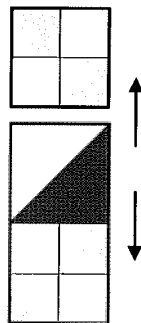
3. Sew a "B" piece to an "D" piece. Press to the "D" piece. **Make 4.**



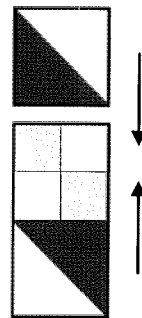
2. Sew two of the step 1 units together. Press in the direction shown. **Make 5.**



4. Sew a step 2 unit to the top and bottom of a step 3 unit. See diagram for layout. **Make 2 rows.**



5. Sew 2 step 3 units to a step 2 unit. **Make 1 row.**



6. Assemble rows.
